Admission Fee \$5 per person at the gate (8 & under free). Grounds Fee \$7 per horse. All classes payback 70%. 3D classes switch to 4D with 65 entries. Classes 5, 6 & 9 include a \$3 sanctioning fee not included in payback. Classes 3, 4, 7 & 8 include \$2 sanctioning fee. All NPBA sanctioned classes include a \$2 awards fee. IBRA approved for KY.

PeeWee riders must be 8 & under as of January 1st, 2021 and cannot ride in any other classes. PeeWee will be placed as assisted rider & unassisted riders. See Lil Buckaroo rules for more info on "assisted" riders.

Roll Overs: Are allowed from Open Barrels to other barrel classes. RO's are to be done at the FULL entry fee price. RO's must be done before Open Barrels begins.
